Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Willie G. Nelson  
 and Malissie G. Nelson his wife, for and in consideration  
 of the sum of Eight Hundred DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by George W. Adams and Chas. Haley  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George W. Adams and Chas. Haley  
 and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western  
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North East quarter of Section 24, Township 19, North,  
Range 11, East

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said George W. Adams and Chas. Haley  
 and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said George W. Adams and Chas. Haley that we will forever  
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Malissie G. Nelson wife of the said Willie G. Nelson for and  
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George W.  
Adams and Chas. Haley all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
