Know all Men by these Presents, That we, L. H. Poe and L. C. Rose
 and Louise Poe and Alice M. Rose their wives, his wife, for and in consideration
 of the sum of Two hundred fifty + 00/100 DOLLARS,
in hand paid us, hereby, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. H. Graig
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western District of Indian Territory, to-wit:

The East half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the
 Southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section
 Twenty Three (23), Township Twenty-Two (22) Range
 Twelve (12), containing five (5) acres, more or less

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. H. Graig
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. H. Graig that we will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And we, Louise Poe and Alice M. Rose wives of the said L. H. Poe and L. C. Rose for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. H. Graig
 all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
