Know all Men by these Presents, That we, L. H. Leone  
and Edith M. Leone his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of One (\$1.00) No/100 DOLLARS,  
Cash in hand paid the receipt of which is  
truly acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Mary E. W. Norton  
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The south one hundred and thirty  
(30) feet, of the east seventy (70) feet, of lot number  
five (5) in block number ninety-two (92) in Tulsa,  
Indian Territory, according to the government plat  
thereof, allowing for the deviation of the Townsite from  
the true meridian, all lines being parallel with the respective lot and  
block lines, being a rectangular piece of ground 70 x 130 feet, having  
twenty feet on Second Street. This deed is made to correct the  
deed of the 19th of the land described in deed made February  
24th 1906  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Mary E. W. Norton

and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mary E. W. Norton that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Edith M. Leone wife of the said L. H. Leone for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mary E.  
W. Norton all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
