do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said James E. Rogers  
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Greek Nation Western  
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot five (5) on Block five (5) in the Stansbury  
Addition to Tulsa City, according to the Recorded  
plat therein

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said James E. Rogers  
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said James E. Rogers that they will forever  
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

and Myrtle C. Stansbury wife of the said John M. Stansbury  
 And I, Katherine M. Day wife of the said John M. Day for and  
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said James E.  
Rogers all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
