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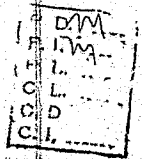
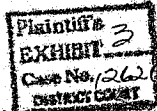

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Josiah Coon and Lucinda J. Coon
 and _____ his wife, for and in consideration
 of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Carl C. Magee
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots One (1), Two (2), (8) eight, and that part of seven
lying north of the creek, Block ninety-five (95)
city of Tulsa, Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Carl C. Magee
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Carl C. Magee that we will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lucinda J. Coon wife of the said Josiah Coon for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Carl C.
Magee all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
