

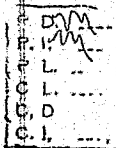

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Lela D. Lindsey of Tulsa 7.  
 and his wife, for and in consideration

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Laura E. Mitchell  
 and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western  
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot One (1) Two (2) and Three (3) in Block one  
(1) of Lindsey's Trust addition to Tulsa according  
to the recorded plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Laura E. Mitchell  
 and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Laura E. Mitchell that she will forever  
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. This deed being made for the  
purpose of correcting a previous deed and the above is checked for the  
same having date May 7th 1907 and recorded May 18-1907 said husband  
being my separate property owned separate and apart from my husband  
 And I, wife of the said for and

in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
