WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Linda Switch + Charles Switch
and her husband his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One Hundred + 00/100 DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid by

James H. Mc Birney
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said James H. Mc Birney
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

and undivided one eighteenth interest in and to the
East Half of the South West Quarter of Section Eight
Township Twenty one, North, Range Thirteen, East of
the Indian Meridian; being all our interest as
heirs at law in the lands allotted in the
Cherokee Nation to Ross Charles, deceased

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said James H. Mc Birney
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said James H. Mc Birney that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever; and that the grantor
Linda is a daughter of William Charles, deceased, who was
a half brother of said Ross Charles
And I, wife of the said for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
