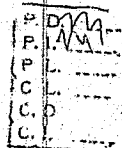

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Frank L. Giddings  
and unmarried his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Two hundred (\$200) DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid by Louis W. Eichelberger

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Louis W. Eichelberger  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Arik Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lot two (2) in Block Twelve (12) of Highlands  
addition to Tulsa C.T. according to the Plat  
thereof filed and at Record in the office of the  
Recorder for the 28<sup>th</sup> Recording District

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Louis W. Eichelberger  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Louis W. Eichelberger that I will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. except a certain  
oil and gas lease dated November 11<sup>th</sup> 1907

And I, wife of the said for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
