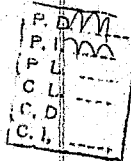

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, R. B. Mc Kingil
and "Single" his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One hundred 00/100 DOLLARS,

The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and same in hand paid by Leslie J. Gannett

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Leslie J. Gannett
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Turkey Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots Eight (8) + Nine (9) + Ten (10) + Eleven (11), Block
Nine (9), according to the Survey + Plat of Turkey
and on.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Leslie J. Gannett
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Leslie J. Gannett that he will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Single wife of the said R. B. Mc Kingil for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

Single all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
