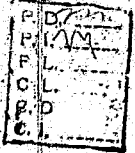

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Alvin J. Hodge
and Mary J. Hodge his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Two Hundred DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid by E. L. Roberts the receipt which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said E. L. Roberts
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots One (1) Two (2) and Three (3) in Block Sixteen (16) of the
Hodge Addition to the Town of Tulsa, I. T. according to the survey and
plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said E. L. Roberts
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said E. L. Roberts that I will forever
warrant and defend the title ^{to} of said lands against all claims, whatever.

And I, Mary J. Hodge wife of the said Alvin J. Hodge for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
E. L. Roberts all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
