The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged
and to us in hand paid by R. E. + L. B. Lynch

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said R. E. + L. B. Lynch
 and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot # Five (5) Block Ninety Eight (98) according to the
"Official Plat" and "Government Survey" of the City of Tulsa
Ind. Ter.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said R. E. + L. B. Lynch
 and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said R. E. + L. B. Lynch that they will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Stella Simmons wife of the said William F. Simmons for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said R. E. + L. B. Lynch
Lynch all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
