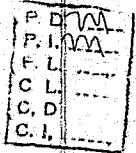

## OFFICIAL FORM

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, el. Elbert Chadwell  
and an unmarried man, his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of One thousand DOLLARS,  
to me cash in hand paid by William L. Chadwell,  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said William L. Chadwell  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation, <sup>the</sup> Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: all that portion of lot three (3) in  
Block One Hundred and Ninety-Three (193) in the City of Tulsa  
particularly described by metes and bounds, as follows, to-wit:  
Beginning at the Southeast corner of said lot three (3) and running  
thence Northwesterly along South Eugene Avenue a distance  
of Forty-Five (45) feet; thence Southwesterly, at right angles  
to said Avenue, to the south line of said lot three (3); and  
thence due East, along the south line of said lot three (3),  
to the Point of Beginning

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said William L. Chadwell  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said William L. Chadwell that el will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
