Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Samuel E. Dunn  
and Lottie H. Dunn his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Twelve hundred + 00/100 DOLLARS,  
cash in hand paid by Allen Gould, the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Allen Gould  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lot No. Four (4) in Block No. Three (3) in the  
Lindsey's First Addition to the Town of Tulsa, ac-  
cording to the recorded plat and survey thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Allen Gould  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Allen Gould that we will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lottie H. Dunn wife of the said Samuel E. Dunn for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Allen Gould  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
