Know all Men by these Presents, That we, George E. Lowe and wife
 and Hanna H. Lowe his wife, for and in consideration
 of the sum of one hundred and seventy five DOLLARS,
cash in hand paid by the purchaser

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George Strickland
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Jinks Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Number Ten (10) in Block Number Sixteen (16)
in The Town of Jinks, Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said George Strickland
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said George Strickland that they will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Hanna H. Lowe wife of the said George E. Lowe for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George
Strickland all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
