Know all Men by these Presents, That we, A. B. Norton
and Alice B. Norton his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of \$1000.00 DOLLARS,
Cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said A. B. Hane
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South Twenty five (25) feet of Lot One (1) and the North
Twelve and one half (12½) feet of Lot Two (2) in Block one
hundred and eighty one (181) in the City of Tulsa and J.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said A. B. Hane
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said A. B. Hane that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice B. Norton wife of the said A. B. Norton for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said A. B. Hane
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
