Know all Men by these Presents, That we, G. B. Crawford

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. B. Scott
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

according to the official survey

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said W. B. Scott
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. B. Scott that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Grace A. Crawford wife of the said G. B. Crawford for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. B. Scott
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
