Know all Men by these Presents, That we, George West
and Lizzie West his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of seventy five 75/100 DOLLARS,
The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said John S. Mitchell
and unto His heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the West Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Eighteen (18) Block Seven (7), according to the
"Survey + Plat" of West Tulsa d-5.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said John S. Mitchell
and unto His heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John S. Mitchell that He will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lizzie West wife of the said George West for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John S.
Mitchell all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
