do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said S. W. Rhoads  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following <sup>lands lying in the</sup> Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
Lots number thirteen, fourteen, fifteen and sixteen in block number nineteen in the north side  
addition to the town of Broken Arrow.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said S. W. Rhoads  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.  
And hereby covenant with said S. W. Rhoads that said lands are free from incumbrances, that we will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all <sup>lawful</sup> claims whatever.

And I, Nancy Hurd wife of the said J. S. Hurd for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and ~~relinquish~~ unto the said S. W. Rhoads  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
