TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said
 and unto heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
 And hereby covenants, with said John Bowman that I will forever
 warrant and defend ^{all my right, title and interest to} ~~the title of~~ said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
