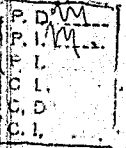

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Alba J. Fountain
and Leanne M. Fountain his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Nineteen Hundred Fifty (1950) DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Wesley M. McAllister receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged and confessed

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Wesley M. McAllister
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the city of Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lot Four (4), Block Three (3) in the George Perryman
addition to the city of Tulsa Indian Territory, according
to the recorded plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Wesley M. McAllister
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Wesley M. McAllister that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Leanne M. Fountain wife of the said Alba J. Fountain for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Wesley M.
McAllister all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
