WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Willey E. Chambers
and Nannie E. Chambers his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Two hundred twenty five DOLLARS,
on hand paid by Alex. S. Lewis, receipt of the same
being hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Alex S. Lewis
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North east quarter of the North-east quarter of the South-west quarter of Section Twenty two (22) Township Twenty (20) North, Range-Thirteen (13) East, The same being Ten acres more or less

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Alex. S. Lewis
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Alex S Lewis that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mamie E. Chambers wife of the said _____ for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Alex S. Lewis
_____ all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
