Know all Men by these Presents, That we, R. M. Stone  
and Helen Stone his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of One 2/100 DOLLARS,  
The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged  
and to us paid by A. B. Stone

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said A. B. Stone  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Bayne Addition <sup>to Tulsa</sup> Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: An undivided one half interest  
in lot sixteen (6) "Bayne Addition" to Tulsa Ind. Ter.  
and according to the "Recorded Plat" thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said A. B. Stone  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.  
And hereby covenant with said A. B. Stone that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Helen Stone wife of the said R. M. Stone for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said A. B. Stone  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
