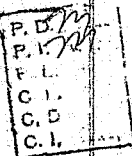

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, H. M. Stonebraker
and Bessie Stonebraker his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Thirteen Hundred 7/10 DOLLARS,
the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to
us in hand paid by Ed. L. Sieg

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Ed. L. Sieg
and unto His heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

West Cor; and the South East Cor of the South East Cor of the South
West Cor of Sec Twelve (12), Twp Nineteen (19) N, Range Twelve (12) East
This is a correction deed made and given in place of one filed in
it do not warrant title against any Oil & Gas Lease on the
land described

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Ed. L. Sieg
and unto His heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ed. L. Sieg that he will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie Stonebraker wife of the said H. M. Stonebraker for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ed. L. Sieg
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
