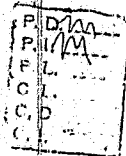

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Jimmie Marshall
and Hannah Marshall his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of one DOLLARS,
and other good and valuable considerations in hand paid
by George W. Adams and Chas Haley, the receipt of which is
heretofore acknowledged
do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George W. Adams and Chas Haley
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The W¹/₂ of SW¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ of NE¹/₄, and The W¹/₂ of the E¹/₂ SW¹/₄
of NW¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ of Section 18 Township 19, North, Range 12 East

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said George W. Adams and Chas Haley
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said George W. Adams + Chas Haley that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Hannah Marshall wife of the said Jimmie Marshall for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George W.
Adams + Chas Haley all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
