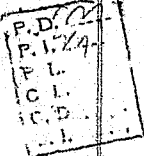

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, A. B. Campbell
and M. M. Campbell his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One thousand fifty + 00/100 DOLLARS,
cash in hand paid by Mercena Wheat, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Mercena Wheat
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lots No. 1 (1) and Two (2) in Block No. 12 (12) in the town of Tulsa, according to the official plat and survey thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Mercena Wheat
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mercena Wheat that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, M. M. Campbell wife of the said A. B. Campbell for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mercena
Wheat all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
