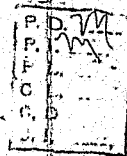

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Clifton George  
and Mary D. George his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of One Hundred \$ — DOLLARS,  
paid by Thomas E. Smiley, receipt of which is hereby  
acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Thomas E. Smiley  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot seven (7), Block Nine (9) Fairview Suburb to  
Duba land, Tex.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Thomas E. Smiley  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Thomas E. Smiley that we will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary D. George wife of the said Clifton George for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Thomas E.  
Smiley all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

## ACKNOWLEDGMENT.
