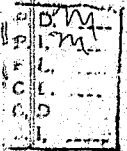

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, J. A. Friend
and Julia A. Friend his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One Thousand (1000 00) DOLLARS,
on hand paid by J. F. Janisch the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. F. Janisch
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Friend Addition to City of Tulsa
Twenty eighth Recording District
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot (7) seven in Block 6, two on the "Friend Addition"
to the City of Tulsa Indian Territory according to the
filed and recorded plat of same

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. F. Janisch
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. F. Janisch that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Julia A. Friend wife of the said J. A. Friend for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. F. Janisch
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
