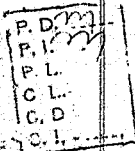

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, J. W. Burgess, a single man
and his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Nine Hundred (900.00) DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. B. Strickland
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Fifty (50) feet off of the south side of Lots Four (4) and
Five (5) in Block One hundred ninety-three (193)
in the City of Tulsa, Okla., according to the recorded
plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said W. B. Strickland
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. B. Strickland that he will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said _____
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
