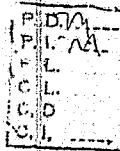

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Henry C. Brockman  
~~and a single man~~ his wife, for and in consideration  
 of the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) DOLLARS,  
 to him in hand paid by E. J. Hayward, the re-  
 ceipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said E. J. Hayward  
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western  
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North Half of Lot Numbered Three in Block Numbered One  
 Hundred Twenty, being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:  
 beginning at the Northeast corner of said Lot Three, thence  
 westerly on lot line 140 feet to northwest corner of said lot,  
 thence southerly on lot line fifty feet, thence easterly  
 parallel with North line of said lot 140 feet to East line  
 of said Lot Three, thence northerly on lot line fifty  
 feet to place of beginning

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said E. J. Hayward  
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said E. J. Hayward that he will forever  
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
