## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Charles C. Mills  
and Laura Mills his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of One (1) DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by Joseph H. Elliott the receipt of  
which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Joseph H. Elliott  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: Lot (14) from in Block 176 One  
hundred and seventy six according to the official survey of the City  
of Tulsa C.T. This deed is made to correct deed filed  
May 25th 1904 and recorded in Book 8, Page 211 - J. H. Elliott  
the grantee in said deed being the same as Joseph  
H. Elliott, the grantee in this deed

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Joseph H. Elliott  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.  
And hereby covenant with said Joseph H. Elliott that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Laura Mills wife of the said Charles C. Mills for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Joseph H.  
Elliott all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
