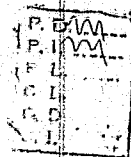

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Frank W. Buel  
and Marie S. Buel his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of \$2250.00 DOLLARS,

Twenty Two hundred, and fifty dollars in hand paid  
by J. M. Bline, the receipt of which is hereby  
acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. M. Bline  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: all of Lot (5) five, and part of Lot (4)

four in Block (176) one hundred, and seventy six described as  
all that part of said Lot four 4 having a frontage of fifty  
(50) feet on Denver Ave, and adjoining Lot five (5) and ex-  
tending one hundred, and forty (40) feet to an alley with a  
uniform width of fifty (50) feet, in the town of Tulsa,  
Indian Territory according to the official plat, and survey  
of said town. This deed made to correct deed filed May 9<sup>th</sup> 1905  
and recorded in Book (5) five Page 279

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. M. Bline  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. M. Bline that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Marie S. Buel wife of the said Frank W. Buel for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. M. Bline  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
