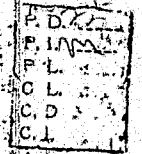

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, A. G. Pittenger
and Lollie W. Pittenger his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Seventeen Hundred and Sixty DOLLARS,
in hand paid by J. R. Fisk, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. R. Fisk
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty seven
(27) Township Eighteen (18) and Range Thirteen East containing 80
acres and being a part of the allotment of Crown Bruner

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. R. Fisk
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said J. R. Fisk that he will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lollie W. Pittenger wife of the said A. G. Pittenger for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
J. R. Fisk all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
