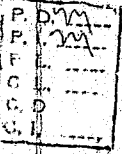

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, J. M. Bline
and Nettie Bline his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Twenty Five Hundred (\$500.00) DOLLARS,
cash hand paid by Nettie B. Fredericks, the receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Nettie B. Fredericks
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: Part of Lot Four (4) in Block one hundred and seventy
six (176), Described as all that part of said Lot (4) four having a frontage of fifty (50)
feet on Denver Ave. and adjoining Lot (5) five and extending one hundred
feet (140) feet to an alley with a uniform width of fifty (50) feet, also a part
of Lot (5) five in Block (176) one hundred, and seventy six, Described as all
that part of said Lot five having a frontage of fifty (50) feet on Denver
ave. and adjoining Lot (4) four, and extending one hundred, and feet (140)
feet to an alley with a uniform width of fifty (50) feet, all situated
in the Town of Tulsa Indian Territory according to the official
plat, and survey of said town
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Nettie B. Fredericks

and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Nettie B. Fredericks that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Nettie Bline wife of the said J. M. Bline for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Nettie B. Fredericks
Fredericks all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
