WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Low R. Stansbery and wife Myrtle C. Stansbery
 and John N. Day and wife Katherine M. Day his wife, for and in consideration
 of the sum of Four Hundred and Fifty Nine no/100 DOLLARS,
 The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to us in hand paid by R. M. Stone

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said R. M. Stone
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot number four (4), Block Three (3), in the Stansbery Addition to the City of Tulsa
 and according to the recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said R. M. Stone
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said R. M. Stone that they will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Myrtle C. Stansbery and Katherine M. Day, wives wife of the said Low R. Stansbery and John N. Day for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
R. M. Stone all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
