Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East

This deed is given for the purpose of correcting a conveyance of this property heretofore  
made between the parties hereto, which is recorded in Book 4, page 82, at Sapulpa, Ind. Ter. the  
the record of which describes the North West quarter of the South East quarter of said  
Section Township and Range

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Mary D. Kreager  
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mary D. Kreager that we will forever
