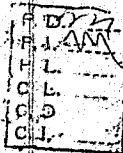

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Frank A. Haver, a single man,  
and John A. Haver and Anna E. Haver, his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) DOLLARS,  
to us in hand paid by S.W. Mann, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said S. W. Mann  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Ouk Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lot Five (5) and Lot Six (6) in Block Two (2) in Riverview  
Addition to the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the recorded  
plat and survey thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said S.W. Mann  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.  
We contract and bind ourselves  
And hereby covenant with said S.W. Mann that we will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. persons claiming the same by and  
through us

And I, Anna E. Haver wife of the said John A. Haver for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
S.W. Mann all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
