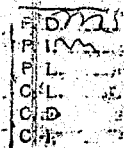

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Grant C. Stebbins and Kate C. Stebbins his wife
and Ethel Davis and Samuel C. Davis her husband his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Twenty Six Hundred DOLLARS,
to be in hand paid by Charles C. Casper the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Charles C. Casper
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North Half of the North West quarter of Section Fourteen, Township Nineteen
North, and Range Eleven East, said land being a portion of the Andy Scott "Deceased"
allotment containing eighty acres more or less

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Charles C. Casper
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Charles C. Casper that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I Kate C. Stebbins wife of the said Grant C. Stebbins

And I, Samuel C. Davis husband of the said Ethel Davis for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

Charles C. Casper all our rights of dower, and homestead in and to the said lands.
