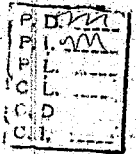

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, J. N. Givens
and Mary J. Givens his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Two thousand & 00/100 DOLLARS,
in hand paid by W. N. Robinson, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. N. Robinson
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South half (1/2) of Lot No. Four (4) in Block No. One hundred
fifty-three (153) in the town of Tulsa, according to the official plat and
survey thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said W. N. Robinson
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said W. N. Robinson that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary J. Givens wife of the said J. N. Givens for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
W. N. Robinson all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
