

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER. *Courtesy*

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, *Lila D. Lindsey*
and *L. W. Lindsey*, her husband *his wife*, for and in consideration
of the sum of *Three Hundred and Fifty* DOLLARS,
to us in hand by *Floyd Corlett* the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said *Floyd Corlett*
and unto *his* heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the *Creek Nation* Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot (12) Block (2) "Lindsey's Second Addition" to the Town of Tulsa
Ind. Terr.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said *Floyd Corlett*
and unto *his* heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said *Floyd Corlett* that *they* will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, *L. W. Lindsey* husband wife of the said *Lila D. Lindsey* for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Floyd Corlett all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
