Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Lila D. Lindsey
and L. W. Lindsey her husband his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Four hundred & fifty DOLLARS,
(450.00) the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged in hand paid by Floyd Corlett to Lila D. Lindsey

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Floyd W. Corlett
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The one Town Lot numbered Six (6) in the Town Block numbered
Eleven (11) located in the second Lindsey addition to Tulsa as per plat
thereof executed by J. Gus Patton

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Floyd W. Corlett
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said Floyd Corlett that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, L. W. Lindsey husband wife of the said Lila D. Lindsey for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Floyd W. Corlett all my rights of ^{*courtesy*} dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
