Know all men by these presents: that, The Cherokee Company, a Corporation, of Tulsa, Indian Territory, owners of the South one half (1/2) of the South-east Quarter (1/4) of Section Thirty one (31) Township twenty (20) North, Range thirteen (13) East, Cherokee Nation, western district, Indian Territory, upon which Cherokee Heights Addition to Tulsa, is located, do hereby remise, release, and relinquish all the Streets, avenues, and Alleys in said Addition to the General Public for public use only; said streets, avenues and alleys to be of the size and dimensions as set forth in the accompanying plat or blue-print as located and surveyed thereon.
