all of the improvements of every name and nature located and situate on the S.W. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 and the S.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 30, Township 22 N. Range 14 East of the Indian Meridian.

The above named improvements consisting of wire fence only.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Pauline Maxfield and Cara Maxfield forever against the claims of all persons whomsoever.
