Know all men by these presents, that in consideration of two thousand
\$2000.00 Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I do hereby
grant, sell, transfer, and deliver unto (Corn and Justice Mayfield their heirs
executors, administrators and assigns, the following goods and chattels, to-wit:
All the improvements situated on the lot of J. E. # of Sec. 16, T. 20 N. R. 13 E. containing of forty acres in the Cherokee
Nation, and also all of said forty acres being in cultivation and under fence.
All of the above improvements having been in my possession since
1891 - to have and to hold all and singular the said goods and chattels
unto said grantee fully secured with said grantee that he is
the lawful owner of said goods and chattels; that they are free from all
incumbrances; that whosoever might seek the same, notwithstanding, and
that she will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims
and demands of all persons whomsoever.
