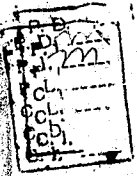

Agricultural Lease

Tulsa, I.T., Nov. 30, 1906

In this day, I, Joe H. Tiger hereby rent and lease for five years from this date for agricultural purposes, the following described land, to William M. Sewell, All of the N.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 24, Township 4 N., Range 12, E. containing forty acres more or less.

Said William M. Sewell shall have the privilege of clearing and disposing of all timbers growing on any portion of said land and I hereby guarantee to him the peaceable possession of said land for the said term of five years.

William M. Sewell is hereby receipted for the payment of Twenty five Dollars cash, and Twenty five Dollars more is to be paid on March the 20th, 1909 providing William M. Sewell has peaceable possession at that time.

The said William M. Sewell is to fence the said forty acres on the West and South with a good two wire fence and said fence is to be on the line and is to be a partnership fence with the owner of the land adjoining.
