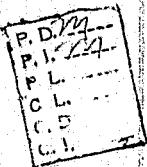

Assignment of Lease.

Know all men by these presents, that for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred fifty dollars cash in hand paid by John T. Jackson to P. A. Fox the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said P. A. Fox does hereby, release, transfer, quitclaim and convey unto the said John T. Jackson, all his right, title and interest in and to a certain lease covering the Northwest quarter of Section 35 Township 18, North Range 14 East, Creek Nation, I. T. in so far as it affects the East half of the Northwest quarter of Section 35, Township 18 North Range 14 East of the land first above described, said lease being executed on March, 14, 1904, by and between Annie Carr and W. G. Bass and which was assigned to Thomas Wiswall and by Thomas Wiswall to W. M. Jaynes and by W. M. Jaynes to P. A. Fox and which was filed for record July 9, 1904 and recorded in book 7M, page 547 in the office of the Deputy Clerk, of the U. S. Court and ex-officio recorder at Wagoner, I. T. and,

also all his right, title and interest in and to a certain lease covering the East half of the North west quarter of Section 35 Township 18, North Range 14 East, Creek Nation, I. T. said lease being executed Oct 26th, 1904 by and between Annie Carr and Thomas Wiswall and which was assigned by Thomas Wiswall to W. M. Jaynes and by W. M. Jaynes to P. A. Fox, and which was filed Oct. 28, 1904 and recorded in book 14M, page 33 in the office of the Deputy Clerk of the U. S. Court and ex-officio recorder at Wagoner, I. T.

The said P. A. Fox hereby covenants and agrees with the said John T. Jackson that he will give possession of the above described premises on or before Jan. 15, 1907, and that he will warrant and defend the possession of same for the term mentioned in the leases, above described.
