

Sixth, Your commissioners therefore beg leave to report the following recommendations; that the north $66\frac{2}{3}$ feet with the four room house, be given to Carrie V. Hanson, the central $66\frac{2}{3}$ feet with the eight room house and well to Daniel W. Burgess, the south $66\frac{2}{3}$ feet with the two room house to Alma V. Gibson, the same being more particularly described as follows; To Carrie V. Hanson the North $46\frac{2}{3}$ feet of Lot Four (4) and the South 20 feet of Lot (3); To Daniel W. Burgess, the North $23\frac{1}{3}$ feet of Lot Five (5) and South $43\frac{1}{3}$ of Lot Four (4); and to Alma V. Gibson the south $66\frac{2}{3}$ feet of Lot five (5); all being in Block Three (3) in the town of North Lewis, Indian Territory, and according to the official plat of survey of said City of Tulsa,

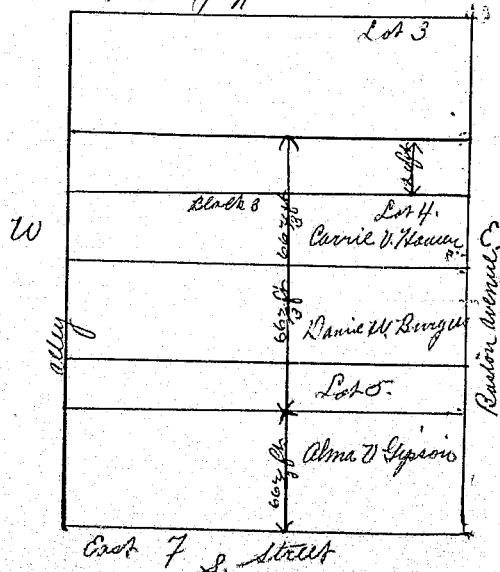
