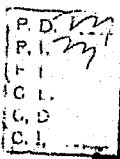

Know all Men by These Presents:

That Cayuga Milling Company, (a Company, incorporated under the laws of the State of Indiana) by E. H. McDaniel and M. G. Hasford, its President and Secretary, respectively, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Charles Hasford (unmarried) and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The North one half of the South-west quarter of Section Eighteen (18) Township Twenty-one (21) North, Range Twelfth (12) East, containing Eighty (80) acres, more or less, the same being the allotment of Mary Spychalski, deceased.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Charles Hasford, and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereto belonging,

and hereby covenants with said Charles Hasford that it will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
