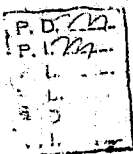

General Warranty Deed

This indenture made and entered into on the 7th day of December, 1906... by and between J. H. Hammons and his wife, Alice Hammons, of Broken Arrow, I.T., parties of the first part and J. T. Barnes, of Broken Arrow, I.T., party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred and sixty five Dollars, (\$1565.00) in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Creek Nation and within the limits of the Indian Territory.

To-wit lots #13, 14, 15, and 16, in block seventy five (75) in the Town of Broken Arrow, I.T., together with all improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Alice Hammons, wife of the said J. H. Hammons for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said land.

To have and to hold said lands unto the said party of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.

In witness whereof to the said parties of the first part has hereunto set their hands and set the day and year first above written.
