To have and to hold the said goods unto the said Ola Jordan her heirs and assigns forever. And I, the said Otto Hallingworth do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the title to said bargained personal property unto the said Ola Jordan, her executors and administrators and assigns from and against the claims of all persons whomsoever.
