Deed of Release.

Know all men by These Presents:

That the Union Trust Company (an Indian Territory Corporation) of Tulsa, Ind. Ter., for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Fifty Two dollars to it paid by Joseph J. Shookey & S. J. Shookey does hereby grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Joseph J. Shookey and S. J. Shookey, and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Western (formerly Northern) District of the Indian Territory to-wit: All of the NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 and SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 Section Five (5) Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirtieth (30) East of the Indian Meridian.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain Mortgage dated March 26th 1906 and recorded in March 28th 1906 at 8 A.M. in Book 9 at Page 520 of the records of Mortgages at Claremore, Ind. Ter.

This deed of release is made by the undersigned officers of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in Article VII of the by-laws of said Company, as follows: "The Secretary shall have equal power with the President to satisfy and release mortgages, judgments or certificates of trust, to execute contracts, releases or other instruments in the transaction of the company's business."
